

We're excited to announce that SciFounders is starting a new program - SciFounder Capital. SciFounder Fellowship will continue to help fledgling scientist founders start their own companies, but with SciFounder Capital we will now be able to help great scientists that are a bit further along as well. SciFounder Capital will do all investments in a way that maximizes long-term control for company founders.

Maintaining control of a research-intensive company is more difficult than for a traditional software or tech company because a lot more capital must be raised to make meaningful progress. This is part of the reason that many such companies get started in a 'top down' way, where venture capitalists end up having very significant control of a company from the beginning. While many important companies have been started this way, we think that it sometimes leads to an overly strong financial focus, which eventually hurts technology development.

Founders seeking to develop ambitious, capital-intensive technologies should not be penalized for their need to amass sufficient resources.

We think keeping the right founders in clear control longer will be a good thing for the future, and one idea we have to help do this is to decouple financial ownership from decision-making power.

SciFounder Capital will pair all investments with a legal pledge to transfer voting rights associated with our shares to either the CEO or the founding team of the company.

We will seek specifically to invest in founders that deserve this leverage — namely ones that can grow into excellent leaders and company builders.
